**SADSAA, SASACC and SASCOC direction: (Full Announcement will be placed on our Web Page)**

- **Gatherings of more than 100 people will be prohibited**
- **It is recommended that all sports competitions/tournaments be cancelled or postponed until further notice**
- **Should your event consist of fewer than 100 people (athletes, officials and spectators), and you are considering continuing with the event, special permission must be granted first by the provincial department of health and then by the deputy director general of national department of health Dr Yogan Pillay: [Ygpillay@gmail.com](mailto:Ygpillay@gmail.com)**

- We appeal to members and visitors to follow these basic guidelines:
  - **As per accepted protocol if you or your spouse have travelled out of country recently (within last 14 days) please avoid visiting the club in order to help us reduce the risk of possible infections. If you or your spouse have travelled to any of the high risk countries (Asian countries, UK, Spain, Iran, Italy or USA) please avoid visiting the club for at least 21 days.**
  - If you are feeling ill (sore throat, dry cough, temperature etc) please try and limit your presence at the club to try and help us reduce the risk of possible infections.
  - Wash your hands often with soap and water for 25 seconds duration. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser (at least 60% alcohol based).
  - Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
  - Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
  - Stay at home when you are sick and try and keep distance from others at home.
  - Practice cough etiquette (maintain distance, cover coughs and sneezes with disposable tissues or clothing, and wash their hands) and if this occurs after travel, report as soon as possible to health care practitioners.
  - Minimise risk by following adequate methods for social distancing by minimizing close contact.

These are certainly difficult times for us all and hope you will understand the position we have taken.
